Missionaries of the UMCA (now part of USPG) first arrived in Zanzibar (now part of Tanzania) in 1863. USPG continues to support each Anglican diocese in Tanzania as they reach out in a local cultural context.

About this Project...

Malnutrition, HIV/AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis are widespread in the Muheza region of Tanzania; the average life expectancy is just 46 years. The Church in Tanzania is responding to this great need by working with communities, providing primary healthcare and health education. Money donated through USPG goes to supporting the general work of Teule Hospital – a large district hospital in Muheza. The hospital, which serves a population of 280,000, most of them subsistence farmers and small traders, also employs a medical officer to promote health in

villages surrounding the hospital. In addition, it runs an immunisation programme. The hospital also runs a training school for both general nurses and midwives. Thanks to the hard work and continual analysis at the hospital, USPG is able to fund what is needed most. In 2004 the hospital was able to build a maternity waiting home. It has 10 beds and is a place for mothers with high risk pregnancies, or those who live far away, to come and stay from about 36 weeks of pregnancy onwards to wait for the onset of labour near to the hospital.
