

Guidance for Leaders

This material is designed for use by groups without any particular expertise. Depending on the size and make-up of the group, the core teaching material might be studied individually in advance of group discussion, or led from the front by someone who has prepared in advance and can facilitate the group dynamics. Whatever the particular context, the material is offered for your *flexible* use; it is not intended that every part is studied in depth, or even necessarily studied at all. Please use your discretion to pick out the sections that will be of most use to your group.
